



Application Information University System of Georgia Students

If your institution participates in the Atlanta Regional Council for Higher Education- ARCHE (www.atlantahighered.org), you may participate in the Cross Registration Program. Contact the Cross Registration Coordinator for your campus for more information. (Note: Most USG institutions in and near Atlanta including Georgia Tech and Georgia State participate in this program.)

If you are at a non-ARCHE institution in University System of Georgia, please read the following information carefully:

- You must be admitted by the University of Georgia as a transient student.
- Do NOT submit the on-line application! Go to the University of Georgia's Undergraduate Admissions website, <http://www.admissions.uga.edu/> and click on the "Apply to UGA" link, click on the "Printable Forms" link, and then click on the "Transfer Application" link. This will bring you to the printable Application for Transfer, Nontraditional, and Transient Admission. Print and complete the PDF version of the application.
- On the application form, indicate the term that you wish to participate, check the "Summer Transient" box and cross out "Summer" to write in "Fall" or "Spring."
- Attach a letter of good standing or an official transcript from your home institution.
- Send the completed application plus the \$50 application fee (make check payable to the University of Georgia) to the Washington Semester Program. The program office will forward your application to the Office of Admissions.

NOTE: Transient applications must be received by the deadlines established by the Office of Undergraduate Admissions (see below). Please plan accordingly and submit your UGA transient application to us in a timely manner.

Fall program: April 1
Spring program: September 15

Please remember that you must also submit the Washington Semester Program application. We require a separate official transcript for this application.

Once you have been accepted as a transient student by UGA and as a participant in the Washington Semester Program, you must submit your immunization documentation to the UGA Health Service.

In order to register for Washington Semester classes at UGA, UGA needs to receive documentation that you are immunized against measles, mumps and rubella. Please complete the form, which you can download from the following link, and submit it to the Health Center, University of Georgia, Athens, GA, 30602 at least six weeks before departure.
